

1. Budget

- ✓ As of 1st of May, \$17,936.60 in account
- ✓ Additional deposits of approximately \$900 made
- ✓ Check paid for landscaping services
- ✓ Check paid for ComEd electric
- √ 1st Quarter dues due end of May
- ✓ 3 lots have overpaid to be applied to next payments due
- ✓ Fines will be assessed for late payments policy to be reviewed and verified
- ✓ There is a budget deficit of approximately \$34 description of issue is forthcoming
- ✓ Board will determine how to adjust budget accordingly funds may be applied from the Entertainment account

2. Existing Business / Outstanding Issues

- ✓ Investigating audit services need to identify an independent resource to perform
- ✓ Retaining wall issues still outstanding
- ✓ Longer-term funds in association checking account may be deposited into a short-term CD for interest gain

3. Entertainment/ Community

✓ Neighborhood garage sale to be Saturday, June 17th. Signs will be placed at the front of the neighborhood to advertise the event. Additional advertising will be placed in the Liberty Suburban and the Daily Herald newspapers.

4. Landscaping

- ✓ Pete has met with the landscaper on a regular basis to review work performed
- ✓ Fertilizer is to be applied in June
- ✓ A portion of common area lawn has been repeatedly missed by the mowers – Pete will review this with the landscape foreman

5. Other Items / New Business

- ✓ A tree plaque memorial has been removed if found, the item can be returned to any board member.
